Good morning and welcome to Antioch! Hear this word from Isaiah 55, and let it call us to worship this morning:

1 "Come, everyone who thirsts, come to the waters; and he who has no money, come, buy and eat! Come, buy wine and milk without money and without price. 2 Why do you spend your money for that which is not bread, and your labor for that which does not satisfy? Listen diligently to me, and eat what is good, and delight yourselves in rich food. Isaiah 55:1-2

Hear the word of the Lord once more from the prophet Isaiah:

6 "Seek the Lord while he may be found; call upon him while he is near; 7 let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts; let him return to the Lord, that he may have compassion on him, and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon. Isaiah 55:6-7

Church, when we forsake our sin, draw near, and call on the Lord in repentance and faith—in other words, when we submit ourselves to him—he has compassion on us and abundantly pardons our sin.
