Call to Worship - Isaiah 61:1-3

Good morning and welcome to Antioch Church! Listen to these words that were fulfilled by the Lord Jesus Christ:

The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord has anointed me to bring good news to the poor; he has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound; to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor, 2 and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn; to grant to those who mourn in Zion-3 to give them a beautiful headdress instead of ashes, the oil of gladness instead of mourning, the garment of praise instead of a faint spirit: that they may be called oaks of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, that he may be glorified. Isaiah 61:1-3

Because Jesus Christ came as the Friend of Sinners, we begin each gathering with a call to worship. Because he offers a welcome to all who see their need, we also welcome all who see their need. Let's receive this welcome by standing and singing of his grace together...

Confession - Matthew 9:10-13

In the Gospel of Matthew we read,

10 And as Jesus reclined at table in the house, behold, many tax collectors and sinners came and were reclining with Jesus and his disciples. 11 And when the Pharisees saw this, they said to his disciples, "Why does your teacher eat with tax collectors and sinners?" 12 But when he heard it, he said, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. 13 Go and learn what this means: 'I desire mercy, and not sacrifice.' For I came not to call the righteous, but sinners." Matthew 9:10-13

The Pharisees thought of friendship as received only for people like them. But Jesus came befriending sinners. Let's take a moment to confess and repent of the ways we avoid friendship with those who are not like us.

Jesus, you chose to live in the midst of enemies like us, Not with the devout, but with the dismissed. If you had not done this, we never would have been spared. Forgive us for ways we fail to also be a friend to sinners, And help us open our lives to those who are not like us. Amen.
