Discussion Questions

- Other Christian traditions give attention to the Transfiguration along the same lines as the Incarnation and the Resurrection. Why don't we? Why do you think Western culture tends to be casual about divine revelation?
- Read Luke 9:18-34. What are some of the many ways God's glory is revealed in this passage? Why does it matter to us?
- Read 2 Corinthians 3:18. In his book *The Weight of Glory*, C.S. Lewis wrote, "Next to the Blessed Sacrament itself, your neighbor is the [most glorious] object presented to your senses." Do you see the glory in fellow believers? In yourself? If yes, how so? If not, why not?
- Read Luke 9:35-36. Which one of these applications strikes a chord with you most right now? Why?
 - Listening for the weight of Jesus' voice in the midst of less weighty voices.
 - Following Jesus not into burnout, but into the silence that exposes the soul.
 - Feasting on Jesus rather than "gnawing on the bones" that our phones provide?
