Jesus Is Better

There Is None Like You (Spontaneous)

Confession-Luke 10:41-42

Let's put ourselves in the story of Mary and Martha in Luke 10 for a moment. These women are preparing for Jesus's arrival to their home. There's a crowd coming. There are errands after errands, an obligation for hospitality, and next to no time to get all the work done. How often does this feel like our lives? And how often do we, like Martha, protest to Jesus,

"Lord, don't you care that [I'm] left to do the work by myself?" Luke 10:40

We are a people distracted by many things, and we overextend and overcommit ourselves regularly. But our real need is not to get all the things done. Our deepest need, like Mary found, is a heart that can be still before Jesus.

Take a moment of quiet to consider this question,

What's keeping me from being still before Jesus?

Brothers and sisters, as Luke writes, Jesus is the good portion, and he will not be taken away from you. Now I invite you to pray this with me:

Lord, help us choose you, now and each day, over all of the well-intended distractions we face. Help us choose the better part. You are the only good portion.
