All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made. In him was life, and the life was the light of men. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it. John 1:1-5

Jesus didn't just become a child, but he is the giver of life to every child. That means you! And that means the children around you right now. Hear this beautiful, good, and true word, and then let's speak it to one another: Jesus made you, and he loves what he made.

Inevitably in a fallen world, some of those circumstances are not good. And yet God's mysterious gift of life is always good. Let's confess this reality along with the psalmist,

I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well. Psalm 139:14
